

Ship Abraham, Barker.
Thursday the 30th of January. A.D. 1851.
Commences with light breezes from the S.W. steering
N.W. 40 sails in sight. employed in ships duties.
middle and latter parts light airs and calms. plenty
of Pin Backs, in sight. Lat 51° 58' south
Long no. obs.

Friday the 31st.
Commences with light airs from the N. heading
N.W. 12 sails in sight. put a new Boat on the
Starboard cranes, middle and latter parts light breezes
plenty of Hump and Pin Backs, in sight. 8 sails in
sight. Lat 48° 58' south.
Long 83.29 West

Saturday the 1st of February.
Commences with fine breezes from the N. steering
N.W. 8 sails in sight. and plenty of Pin Backs, middle
and latter parts the same. Spoke with ship Mary
and Adeline 127 days from New York, bound to
San. Francisco, California. Lat 48.06 south.
Long 84° 33' West.

Sunday the 2nd
Commences with light breezes from the S.E. steering
N.W. 8 sails in sight. with pleasant weather, middle
and latter parts the same. at 6 AM saw several Right
Whales. at 4 PM lowered for them at 8 the Starboard
Boat struck and killed one. at 9 took him along side
and commenced cutting. Lat by Ach. 49° 15' south
Long " " 85. or west

Monday the 3rd
Commences with light airs from the S.E. at 2 P.M.
finished cutting and commenced Boiling. plenty
of Whales in sight. middle part the same. latter
part light airs from the N.W. plenty of Black Fish
in sight. Lat 46° 52' south
Long near obs.

Outward, Bound.
Tuesday the 4th of February. A.D. 1851.
Commences with fine breezes from the N. heading
N.W. employed in boiling. saw a Right Whale going
quick to the N.W. one sail in sight. middle part the
same. at 8 A.M. finished boiling. and washed the decks.
4 sails in sight. Lat 45° 28' south.
Long 83° 16' West.

Wednesday the 5th.
Commences with light breezes from the N. steering
N.W. by 11 set the Studding sails. three sails in sight. middle
and latter parts the same broke out for water. and Broad.
with pleasant weather. Lat 43° 54' south.
Long no. obs.

Thursday the 6th
Commences with fine breezes from the S. steering
N.W. middle and latter parts the same 4 sails in
sight and plenty of Pinbacks. Lat 42° 06' south.
Long 84° 35' West.

Friday the 7th
Commences with fine breezes from the S.E. steering
N.W. by N. middle and latter parts the same employed in
steering down. two sails in sight. Lat 40° 07' south.
Long

Saturday the 8th.
Commences with light breezes from the S. steering
N.W. by N. employed in steering down. two sails in sight. with
pleasant weather. middle part squally with rain. latter
part light airs and calms. Lat 37° 42' south.
Long no. obs.

Sunday the 9th
Commences with light breezes from the N.W. steering
N.W. one sail in sight. middle and latter parts the
same. with pleasant weather. Lat 36° 50' south.
Long 83° 55' West.
