 Saturday the 26th of April A.D. 1851
 Commenced with fine breezes from the S.W.
 steering N.W. employed in repairing sails ship
 St. George in sight middle part fresh breezes at
 3 A.M. the wind hauled to the N. with rain took
 in the topgallant sails. Double reefed the top sails.
 Lat 34° 28' N
 Long 168° 24' E

Sunday the 27th
 Commenced with strong breezes from the N.W.
 heading N.W. middle and latter parts fine
 breezes from the S.E. one sail in sight.
 Lat 36° 14' N
 Long 168° 24' E

Monday the 28th
 Commenced with fresh gales from the S. steering
 N.W. with rainy weather one sail in sight.
 middle part the same. latter part the wind
 hauled to the N. the ship under double reefed
 top sails main sail and jib. Lat 39° 22' N
 Long 166° 24' E

Tuesday the 29th
 Commenced with fresh gales from the N. steering
 N.W. one sail in sight took in the jib middle
 part the same. latter part more moderate shook
 the reefs out of the top sails. Lat 41° 08' N
 Long 166° 24' E

Wednesday the 30th
 Commenced with light breezes from the S.E.
 steering N.W. with misty weather middle
 part variable winds with rain. latter part
 strong ~~breezes~~ gales from the N.W. brought
 her down to a close reefed main top sails.
 Lat 43° 44' N
 Long 166° 30' East.

 Commenced with moderate gales from the N.W.
 heading N. under double reefed top sails and courses
 middle and latter parts squally with snow and rain.
 Lat 45° 04' N

Friday the 2nd
 Commenced with fresh gales from the N. steering
 N.W. with snow squalls middle and latter parts
 the same. Lat 47° 36' N
 Long 167° 52' E

Saturday the 3rd
 Commenced with moderate breezes from the N.W.
 heading N.W. saw a French ship. middle and
 latter parts light breezes. Lat 48° 27' N
 Long 168° 44' E

Sunday the 4th
 Commenced with light breezes from the N.E.
 steering N.W. by N middle part the same latter
 part fresh breezes from the N.W. Lat 48° 48' N
 Long 168° 44' E

Monday the 5th
 Commenced with fresh breezes from the N. heading
 N.W. middle and latter parts light and variable
 winds with snow squalls. Lat 50° 08' N
 Long 165° 00' E

Tuesday the 6th
 Commenced with light breezes from the N.W.
 heading N. middle and latter parts variable
 winds with snow. at 10 A.M. lowered for two
 Right Whales. at 12 same on Board. Lat 51° 28' N
 Long 165° 00' E

Wednesday the 7th
 Commenced with light airs and calms.
 middle and latter parts fresh breezes from the
 N.W. with snow squalls. Lat 52° 00' N
 Long 167° 45' E.
