March 17th } Commences with light winds and heavy swell from the E. S. E. steering N. E. sheet out the reefes and set the Topgallant sails. Middle part the same. Gutter part fresh breezes from the E. steering N. N. E. Lat 16. 57.5 Lat by Act 145. 47.7

Thursday
March 18th } Commences with fresh breezes from the E. steering N. N. E. Middle and Gutter parts. Fine breezes from the E. S. E. employed in ship's duties. Lat 15. 53.5 Lat by Act 147. 53.1
