March 17th } Commences with light winds from the
E. S. E. steering N. by W. Bent another
Fore sail. Middle, and Latter parts
the same set the fore topmast studding
sail Lat 17^o 02' N
Long 149^o 55' W

Saturday
March 20th } Commences with light winds from the
E. S. E. steering N. by W. Middle and
Latter parts the same Lat 18^o 07' N
Long 150^o 31' W

Sunday
March 21st } Commences with fine breezes from the
S. E. steering N. by W. Middle part the
same. Latter parts fresh breezes from
the South. Lat 19^o 30' S
Long 152^o 51' W

Monday
March 22nd } Commences with fresh gales from the
S steering N. took in the fore galls and
Latter. Kept the fore sails. Saw several
pumpers. Middle part more moderate, with
rain. Latter part the wind hauled to
the N. made all sail. steering N. by E.
Lat 20^o 02' N
Long by Jet 156^o 25' W

Tuesday
March 23rd } Commences with fresh breezes from the
N. E. steering N. by E. with thick squally
Weather. Middle part light and variable
winds. at 11 A.M. saw the Island of
Owhyhee. Latter part moderate breeze
from the N. E. at Day Light saw Mowee.
Bearing N. by E. Lat 20^o 30' S
Long

Wednesday 1832
March 24th } Commences with fresh breezes from the N. E.
with rainy weather. steering along the Land
for the Passage. Middle part the same.
Latter part fresh breezes from the E. steering
down the Passage.

Thursday
March 25th } Commences with light winds from the
E. steering for the Anchorage at 2 P.M.
at Day in Port. Came to an Anchor of Tahaina in 20
fathoms of Water. 26 sail in Port.

Wednesday
March 31st } Commences with light winds from the
N. E. at 5 P.M. took our Anchor, and
steered for Honolulu. at 5 A.M. saw the
Island of Oahu. at 8 the Captain went
ashore. the ship lying of and on in company
with several others.

Thursday
April 1st } Commences with strong winds from the
N. E. the ship lying of and on the Captain
ashore. middle part the same. Latter
part more moderate. at 8 A.M. the
Boat went ashore.

Friday
April 2nd } Commences with fresh winds from the
N. E. the ship lying of and on. Middle
and Latter parts strong winds. the ship
lying of and on Honolulu with the Captain
ashore.
