

Ship Abraham Barker, Captain Norton. Master

Saturday 1832

April 3<sup>rd</sup> } Commences with strong winds from the N.E. the ship lying by and on Honolulu at 3 P.M. the Captain came aboard and steered N. Middle part the same at 3 A.M. saw the Island of Oahu bearing S.W. Latter part more moderate at 6 A.M. the Captain went ashore to trade & spoke with ship *Hibernia* of New Bedford 3 months out.

Sunday

April 4<sup>th</sup> } Commences with fresh winds from E.N.E. lying by and on Oahu at 4 P.M. the Captain came on board and steered S.W. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate steering W by S. Lat 20° 52' N Long 171° 36' W

Monday

April 5<sup>th</sup> } Commences with moderate winds from N.E. steering W by S. Middle and Latter parts the same employed in mending the *Wizen* Tapsail Lat 20° 51' N Long 163° 00' W

Tuesday

April 6<sup>th</sup> } Commences with moderate winds from N.E. steering W by S. Middle part variable winds with rain. Latter parts light winds from the E Lat 20° 40' N Long 163° 00' W

Wednesday

April 7<sup>th</sup> } Commences with moderate winds the E.N.E. steering W by S. Middle and latter parts light and variable winds employed in mending sails Lat 20° 47' Long 163° 00' W

From the Sandwich Islands to the North Pacific 1832

Thursday 1832

April 8<sup>th</sup> } Commences with light airs and calms steering W by S employed in mending sails Middle part the same. Latter part light winds from the N.E. with pleasant weather. Lat 20° 48' N Long 163° 00' W

Friday

April 9<sup>th</sup> } Commences with light winds from the N.E. steering W by S. Middle part steady. Latter part light winds from the N. employed in mending sails in the *Wizen* Tapsail. Lat 20° 31' N Long 171° 36' W

Saturday

April 10<sup>th</sup> } Commences with light winds from the N.E. steering W by S. Middle and Latter parts the same with pleasant weather. Lat 20° 29' N Long 171° 36' W

Sunday

April 11<sup>th</sup> } Commences with fine breezes from the N. steering W by S. with pleasant weather. Middle part squally. Latter part fresh breezes from the N.E. Lat 20° 20' N Long 176° 05' W

Monday

April 12<sup>th</sup> } Commences with fresh breezes from the E steering W by S. Middle part the same. Latter part strong breezes employed in breaking out between decks. Lat 20° 44' N Long 178° 57' W

Tuesday

April 13<sup>th</sup> } Commences with fresh breezes from the E.N.E. steering W by S. employed in mending sails of this duty. Middle and Latter parts the same with pleasant weather. Lat 21° 43' N Long by clock 179° 10' E
