September 8th } Commences with fresh winds from the S.W. with hazy weather. several sail in sight. spoke with Ship Alice Mandell. 12 Whales Middle part strong gales. Latter part more moderate spoke with Ship Mary 14 Whales 62 sail and several Whales in sight. spoke with Ship Niagara. 22 Dec. Lat 68° 35' Long 111° 20'

Monday Sept 9th

} Commences with fresh winds from the S.E. 40 sail and plenty of Whales in sight. spoke with Ship Vineyard. 11 Whales Lowered for Whales. at 3 P.M. the Bon Boat struck and saved a Polar Whale at 8 took it alongside and commenced cutting. Middle part foggy. Latter part fresh winds from the S.W. at 9 left Kinohill cutting. spoke with Ship Lydia. 14 Whales. Lat 68° 43' Long 111° 45' W

Tuesday

Sept 10th

} Commences with strong winds from the E.N.E. several sail in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate. Lowered for Whales without success at 8 A.M. started the hawks. Lat 68° 45' Long 111° 43' W

Wednesday Sept 11th

} Commences with moderate winds from the E.N.E. with Rainy weather. employed in Boiling gaming with several ships. Middle and Latter parts light winds with foggy several sail in sight. Lat 68° 36' Long

Friday

Sept 10th

} Commences with fresh winds from the N.W. with foggy weather. Ship heaving different ways at 4 A.M. finished Boiling. Middle part the same. Latter part fresh gales with hazy weather. steering S.W. at 11 A.M. East Cape. Bearing S.W. No Observations

Saturday

Sept 11th

} Commences with fresh gales from the N. steering through the Straits. at 2 P.M. Passed East Cape. 10 sail in sight. with pleasant weather. Middle and Latter parts the same employed in Steaming. Cile. at 10 A.M. Passed St. Lawrence Island. Lat 63° 42' Long

Sunday

Sept 12th

} Commences with fresh gales from the N.E. steering S.W. with pleasant weather. spoke with Ship Warren of Fishery. Middle part the same. Latter part foggy. Lat 61° 05' Long

Monday

Sept 13th

} Commences with strong winds from the E.N.E. with foggy weather. steering S.W. Middle part the same. Latter part more moderate with cloudy weather. Lat 58° 26' Long
