November 30th } Commenced with light winds from the N.W. steering S.E. by E. Perry Island in sight. Middle part fresh winds from the E. & E. steering N.W. & at 4 P.M. made the Island of Whytotacke at 8 the Captain went ashore.

Wednesday

December 1st } Commenced with moderate winds from the N. the ship. Lying of and on Whytotacke at 2 P.M. took a raft ashore for water and got of Wood. S. & Middle and Latter parts light winds from the S.W. got of the water.

Thursday

Dec 2nd } Commenced with light winds from the S.W. the ship. Lying of and on Whytotacke. employed in storing water and getting of Reemits. Middle and Latter parts the same.

Friday

Dec 3rd } Commenced with light winds from the S. the ship. Lying of and on Whytotacke. employed in getting of Reemits. landed seven men. at 7 P.M. the Captain. Come in Board. and steered to the N. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat. 19° 05'

Saturday

Dec 4th } Commenced with moderate winds from the S. heading N.W. with pleasant weather. Middle and Latter part Light winds from the S.E. heading N.W. sent a new spanker. Lat 19° 33'

December 5th } Commenced with light winds from the S.E. heading N.W. Middle and Latter the same. Lat 21° 23' S.

Monday

Dec 6th } Commenced with fresh winds from the S.E. heading N.W. Middle and Latter. light winds from the E. steering S by E. employed in splicing in the main Rigger. Lat 23° 10' S.

Tuesday

Dec 7th } Commenced with light winds from the S.E. steering S. by E. employed at work on the main Rigger. Middle part the same. Latter part light winds from the N. steering S.E. by E. Lat. 25° 01' S.

Wednesday

Dec 8th } Commenced with light winds from the N.W. steering S.E. by S. employed at work on the main Rigger. Middle and Latter parts the same. Lat 26° 14' S.

Thursday

Dec 9th } Commenced with light winds from the N.W. steering S.E. by S. employed at work on the Rigger. Middle part the same. Latter part variable winds with rain squalls. Lat. 27° 15'

Friday

Dec 10th } Commenced with fresh winds from the S.E. heading E. with rainy weather. Middle and Latter parts, Cloudy weather. Lat 28° 50' S.
