} Commences with fresh gales from the N.W. steering E by S. with squally weather. Middle part the same. Latter part strong winds from the N.W.

} Commences with strong winds from the N.W. steering E by S. with squally weather. Middle part the same. Latter part strong gales from the S.W. took in the studding sails. Lat 46° 23'

} Commences with strong gales from the N.W. steering E by S. with squally weather. Middle and Latter parts more moderate. at 12 M. the wind hauled N.W. with rain. Lat 49° 00'

Dec 30th

} Commences with strong winds from the N.W. steering E by S. with rainy weather. Middle part wind hauled to the N. double reefed the Top sails. Latter part more moderate. took out the reefs. Lat 50° 20'

Long 105° 38'

Friday

Dec 31st

} Commences with strong gales from the S.W. with squally weather steering E under double reefed Top sails. Middle part more moderate. Latter part wind hauled to the N. set all sail. steering E by S.

Lat 51° 30' S
