January 20th } Commenced with strong winds from
the N.W. steering N.E. by N. Middle
Part wind lanted N.W. Latter part
fresh gales from the same quarter Lant
refed the Top sails. Lat 37. 15 S
Long 34. 10 W

Friday
Jan 21st } Commenced with fresh gales from
the N. steering N.E. by N. under reefed
Top sails Middle Part more moderate
made all sail Latter part wind
lanted to the N. Bent a new main top
sailant sail. Lat 34. 57
Long 31. 21.

Saturday
Jan 22nd } Commenced with strong breezes from
the N.W. steering N.E. imp. light air.
Repairing sails Middle part the same.
Latter part wind lanted to the N.W.
with Pleasant weather. Lat 32. 21
Long 28. 57

Sunday
Jan 23rd } Commenced with light breezes from the
S.W. steering N.W. Middle part light
air and variable. Latter part light winds
from the E. Lat 30. 55
Long 28. 30

Monday
Jan 24th } Commenced with light and variable
winds heading on different backs with
Pleasant weather. Middle part strong
winds from the N.W. lashed ship to
the N.E. double reefed the Top sails.
Latter part fresh gales with squally
weather & Rain. Lanted the Main sail &
fifth. one sail in sight.
Lat 30. 00 S
Long 28. 27 W

Thursday 1853 }
January 25th } Commenced with strong gales from the
N.W. heading N.E. under double reefed
Top sails. & exchanged Signals with an
English Merchant Ship. Middle part fresh
breezes from the N.W. Latter part equally
with Rain. Lat 28. 25 S
Long 28. 26 W

Wednesday
Jan 26th } Commenced with fresh breezes from
the N.W. heading N.E. with squally
weather & Rain. Middle and Latter
Parts the same. Lat 27. 16
Long 27. 26

Thursday
Jan 27th } Commenced with fresh winds from the
N. heading E.N.E. with squally weather
& Rain. Barred away the Mastingsale.
Middle part the same. Backed to the N.
N.W. Latter part backed to the E.N.E.
one sail in sight. Lat 26. 07
Long 24. 12

Friday
Jan 28th } Commenced with fresh winds from
the N. heading E.N.E. Middle &
Latter parts the same heading on different
backs. Lat 25. 36
Long 24. 15

Saturday
Jan 29th } Commenced with light winds from
the N. heading on different backs.
Bent a new fore & main Top sail.
Middle and Latter parts light winds
from N.W. heading N.W. employed
at sundry jobs of ship's duty.
Lat 24. 57
Long 23. 40
