Parts strong winds from S.E. Lat 26. 48

March 3rd } Commences with fresh gales from S.E.
steering N.W. by N. Threwed Overboard a
Jug Pot and old Boat. Middle part squally
with Rain and Lightning Latter part
fresh winds from the S.W. with Rain.

March 4th } Commences with light variable winds
with cloudy weather. at 2 P.M. tooked
ship to N.W. Middle part the same
Latter part light air from the S.E.
