Prof 20 Breezes 4 cups rice one cup of one Whiff of Brand 160 gallons one cup of Brand 500 gallons one cup of small lines 3 miles 60 half full of Dapple one cup of Butter one cup of oil of mind and latter part strongy Breezes from the N.W. with pleasant weather sounds the Day

Remarks on Board October Wednesday the 18

The 24 hours begins with strongy breezes from the N.W. with thick Cloud, weather at 11 P.M. lighter coming along side and thick. Out three loads mind part strongy Breezes from the N.W. Latter part strongy Breezes from the N.W. with light Breezes sounds the Day

Remarks on Board Thursday October the 19

The 24 hours begins with strongy breezes from the N.W. with Cloud weather the Day coming a lighter load mind part calm. With pleasant weather latter part strongy breezes from the N.W. with strongy rain with strongy rain sounds the Day

Remarks on Board October Friday the 20

The 24 hours begins with light Breezes from the N.W. with Pleasant weather at 8 P.M. went on shore to get water for the Brig refuted 80 Barrels of the Day. At 9 A.M. the carpenter examined the Brig mind part strongy Breezes from the N.W. with latter part light Breezes from the N.W. with strongy Breezes from the N.W. and pleasant
