

Remarks on board Tuesday January 1st 1843

Commenced with with calm. hilling. middle
calm finished hilling. latter part calm. heavy
weather commenced steering down so ends

Monday 2nd

Commenced calm. employed steering down
middle & latter part the same

Lat. 31-00
Long. 3. 28

Tuesday 3rd

Commenced calm with heavy weather empty
steering down middle part wind the same
finished steering down latter part moderate
winds from N.W. steering S.W. of A.M. raised
a school of sperm whales towards 3 o'clock
without success. at 11 o'clock gave the boat
so ends

Wednesday 4th

Commenced with moderate winds from N.W.
steering on a wind to E.S.E. 7 P.M. shortened
sail middle part the same latter part same
5.4 M. made sail and raised sperm whale
lowered and struck 3 saved 2. so ends

Thursday 5th

Commenced with light winds from N.W.
with pleasant weather chasing whales 5 P.M. got
2 alongside & commenced cutting 8 P.M. finished
cutting & shortened sail. middle part same N.W.
same same latter part same 7 A.M. commenced
hilling set for main topsail single reef so ends

Lat. 30-21

Friday 6th

Commenced with strong breeze from N.W.
steering N. squally weather. 5 P.M. shortened sail
middle part the same latter part the same
finished hilling so ends

Remarks on board Saturday Jan 7th 1843

Commenced fresh breeze from N.W.E. steering
on a wind to N.W. employed clearing up decks
middle part. fresh breeze from N.W. heading to
W by N under foresail and main topsail
latter part wind the same 5 A.M. set jib & single
reef topsails steering to the S & N so ends

Sunday 8th

Commenced with moderate winds from N.W. by W
steering to E.S.E. under all sail. 7 P.M. shortened
sail middle part the same 1 A.M. wore ship
latter part the same commenced steering down
12 A.M. finished steering down so ends

Lat. 30-20

Monday 9th

Commenced with light winds from N.W.
made all sail steering to E.S.E. 3 P.M. raised
sperm whales towards 4 o'clock & saved 2
5 P.M. got them alongside and shortened
sail middle part same preparing for cutting
latter part wind the same 7 A.M. commenced
cutting 11 A.M. finished cutting so ends

Tuesday 10th

Commenced with light winds from N.W.
steering to E.S.E. with pleasant weather. hilling
middle part the same latter part the same
so ends

Lat. 30-25
Long. 3. 23

Wednesday 11th

Commenced with light winds from N.W. steering
on a wind to N.W. with pleasant weather under
all sail 7 P.M. finished hilling 7 P.M. shot in top
gallant sails middle part the same latter
part calm & baffling winds so ends

Long. 3. 56
