

Remarks on board Thursday 12th 1843

Commenced with calm & light baffling winds with showers of rain 7 PM. Shuttled sail. middle part the same. latter part light wind from S.E. steering S.W. 5 AM. luff to the wind & under S.W. & commenced steering down to wind

Friday 13th

Commenced with calm slight winds from S.E. heading to S.W. steering down 2 PM. fresh winds & heavy sea with showers of rain 6 PM. commenced steering down & were ship to S.W. middle part the same latter part strong breeze from S.E. steering on a wind to S.W. with a heavy sea & light air. luff the top

Saturday 14th

Commenced with strong winds from S.E. steering on a wind to S.W. with a heavy sea. under close reef topsails & lower sails. 7 PM. set the watch. whole watches. Middle part the same. latter part more moderate 7 AM. were ship to S.W. by N. set topsails single top and main top. 9 AM. set sail so ends

Sunday 15th

Commenced with fresh winds from S.E. steering on a wind to S.W. by N. with pleasant weather. middle & latter the same. under all sail so ends

Monday 16th

Commenced with light winds from S.E. steering on a wind to S.W. by N. under all sail with pleasant weather. middle & latter part calm so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday 17th 1843

Commenced with light air from N. steering to S.E. under all sail with pleasant weather. middle part the same. latter part fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.E. by E. so ends

Wednesday 18th

Commenced with moderate winds from N.W. steering to S.E. by E. with pleasant weather. middle & latter part the same so ends

Thursday 19th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. steering to S.E. by E. with pleasant weather. 1/2 past 2 AM. saw a ship to windward steering to S.E. middle part the same 1 AM. spoke the Providence. Regatta. Brig Waterwheel. latter part the same 10 AM. set out five topmast & lower studding sails so ends

Long. 2.43 East

Friday 20th

Commenced with fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.E. pleasant weather 4 PM. wind luff to N.W. 8 PM. wind luff to S.W. with strong breeze took in studding sails top gallant sails 10 PM. took in jib & double reef the topsails & main & foremast. latter part more moderate set main & fore jib & single reef topsails & main top gallant sail so ends

Lat. 31.12
Long. 2.5

Saturday 21st

Commenced with strong breeze from S.W. steering S.E. 7 PM. took in main top gallant sail & S.M. jib. 9 PM. main sail & fore top. fore topsail middle part same. latter part breeze luff to S.W. set jib main sail & single reef fore topsail 10 AM. wind luff to S.E. so ends
