

Remarks on board Sunday March 7th 1843

Commenced with light air from N.W. 2 P.M.
light winds from S.W. steering N under all
sail. Middle part same. Latter part calm
with heavy rain squalls so ends

Wednesday 8th

Commenced with light winds from N.W. steering
E.S.E. 2 P.M. wind from W. steering N.W. Middle
part calm squalls with wind from S.W. steering
N. latter part same pleasant weather so ends

Thursday 9th

Commenced with light winds from S.W. steering
N.W. under all sails. Middle & latter
part calm & light air heading N.W. so ends

Lat. 17-00
Long. 39-00

Friday 10th

Commenced with light air from E. steering
N.W.E. 3 P.M. saw Spinn Whales to windward
sailed without success middle part wind N.W.E.
latter ship to E. still in sight. Calm sails & jibs
latter part went to N.W.E. so ends

Saturday 11th

Commenced with light air from N.W.E.
steering to E. under all sail. Middle & latter
part calm & light baffling winds heading to
the N.W. so ends

Lat. 15-55
Long. 39-15

Sunday 12th

Commenced with light air N.W. heading N.W.
with pleasant weather. Middle part calm
latter part fresh breezes from N. steering
on a wind to E.S.E. so ends

Long. 42-34

Remarks on board Monday March 13th 1843

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.W. steering
on a wind to E.S.E. under all sail. Middle &
latter part same so ends

Lat. 15-20
Long. 42-39

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with light winds from N.W. steering
on a wind to E.S.E. under all sail. Middle & latter
part calm & light baffling winds heading to the
E.S. ends

Lat. 15-30
Long. 43-38

Wednesday 15th

Commenced with light baffling air heading
to the N.W. under all sail. Middle part same
latter part light winds from N. heading to
the N.W. so ends

Lat. 15-09
Long. 43-66

Thursday 16th

Commenced with fresh winds from N.W. steering
N.W. under all sail. Middle part wind from
E. steering E.S.E. latter part heavy squalls from
E.S.E. heading to N.W. with heavy rain & wind

Lat. 15-14
Long. 44-28

Friday 17th

Commenced with light winds from N.W. steering
under all sail to N.E. middle & latter part
light breezes from N.W. under all sail to
N.E. so ends

Lat. 14-54
Long. 44-27

Saturday 18th

Commenced with calm & light air heading
to the N.W. E. middle & latter part the same
so ends

Lat. 14-10
Long. 44-27
