Commenced with calm, misty & latter part
light winds from NW steering S. S. E. & S. N. E.
saw the island of Nagotta bearing S. S. E. 30
miles distant. 20 miles

Commenced with light winds from S.W. steering
N.W. the Islands of Mayotte, Johannah &
Mozilla in sight. Middle part light winds
latter part same steering N.W. by N. along
Johannah then N. short haul wind with the
march stands between 10 ends

Thursday 21st

commenced with light winds from N by E
steering N by W. ~~W~~ bearing Johanna on but
in sight sun set. shortened sail and set
the watch. Barks baros middle part heavy
rain with squalls latter part moderate breeze
from N steering in for Johanna made all
sail & at 11 fair commencing bearing S by E distant
45 miles sound

commenced with light winds from S steering
for Johanna & P.M. spoke Bull River
of Fairhaven Capt. Gilden & men the oct. 15th Spent
6 P.M. took in top Gallant sails Middle & tall
part light winds with squalls & rain so ended

Commenced with light winds from S.W. & a
in for the fort 3 P.M. sent boat in there
and got a pilot 4 P.M. landed 2 Boats
tower Big in the fort. Middle party light
side 11 P.M. yet got 2 Staked Anchors in
12 Gallons latter part calm & winds

Remarks on board Friday 24th March 1827

Commenced with calm weather. Boat crew
on shore filling water. Middle gun. Calm
latter part. Got off east center station. It
drew. Capt. sent at once Joseph Ximenes David & Stuart
Mr. Newsham. Mr. Mil. Then dead men. It drew in Stuart him again.
When Mr. Mil. struck him with a knife. He was on which a Portuguese
captain duty sent for Capt. and they. Lying at anchor.
Went to duty again. Capt. Ximenes in arms.

Saturday 23

Commenced with calm pleasant weather
Boats were within falling water. Middle part
calm. Latter part got off Cape water &
stowed it down. Cape side sounds

Commenced with calm pleasant weather
Boats crew ashore filling water Middle part
calm Middle part calm latter part calm
Schooner & North Boats crews ashore on liberty
Capt Smith ~~so~~ ^{came to anchor}

her Capt Smith doctor from the English ship came
aboard to see the Capt & send. Lt. James returned
to his duty - Lying at anchor
