Commenced calm harbor water ashore on liberty
at 10 am down came on board Middle part calm
latter part light winds from E. Harbor water
ashore on liberty Cap. Smith

Thursday 30th

Commenced with fresh breeze from E. Harbor
water ashore on liberty middle part calm. The
Ship the Subaltern & Part. Bree got under way
landward the water came on board latter part calm
so water Cap. Smith Harbor water ashore on liberty

Friday 31st

Commenced with calm Harbor water ashore
on liberty down came aboard middle part
calm latter part calm Harbor water ashore
on liberty employed getting off wood Cap. Smith

Saturday April 1st

Commenced calm Harbor water on liberty down
came on board employed getting off wood Middle
part calm latter part calm Harbor water on liberty
employed getting off wood at 10 am got on deck so
Monsieur Naga left on shore with powder case of Adolph
Raf

Sunday 2nd

Commenced calm Harbor water on liberty down
came on board employed getting off wood middle
part calm latter part calm Harbor water on shore
on liberty winds

Monday 3rd

Commenced light winds Harbor water on
shore Part. Tansons of Avon came to anchor &
Part. Marcella of New Bedford 12 m. out 400
Spinn down with came on board Middle
part calm latter part calm Harbor water on shore
on liberty getting off of October & Fruit

Remarks on board Tuesday 4th April 1865

Commenced calm Harbor water on shore on
liberty getting off of October down came on
board Middle part calm latter part calm
Harbor water ashore on liberty so ends

Wednesday 5th

Commenced calm Harbor water on shore
on liberty getting off of October down came on
board Mary Barbara of Archd. & came to anchor
Middle part calm latter part getting ready for
sea so ends

Lying to anchor

Thursday 6th

Commenced calm getting for sea Middle part
light winds from E. & P.M. took air anchor
and said in company with the Mary Barbara
latter part light baffling winds Johanna
in sight bearing 1.18. 20 miles distant so ends

Friday 7th

Commenced calm Middle light winds under
all sail to N by E latter part fresh breeze from
S by E steering under all sail to N by E and
Part. Comm. N.W. bearing 1.18. 25 miles

Saturday 8th

Commenced with fresh breeze from E by E
steering N.W. the sun down shortened sail at 1.18.
to the wind bearing E by N Middle part the latter
latter part fresh breeze from S.E. & S.W. made all
sail steering N.W. 1.18. 25 miles Grand Chimera
bearing 1.18.

Sunday 9th

Commenced light winds from S.E. steering
to N.E. under all sail sun down shortened sail
Middle part same latter part same
Made all sail steering N.E. by N so ends
