 employed taking care of the sick
 middle of latter part rain

Monday June the 3rd
 Commenced with cloudy weather
 employed taking care of the sick
 middle of fine latter part fine weather
 employed getting ready to sail the Brig
 & talking at publick sail with all her
 apparatus

Tuesday June the 4th
 Commenced fine weather employed
 taking care of the sick & getting ready
 to sail the Brig & all of apparatus
 middle of latter part fine weather
 at 11 A.M. sailed the Brig Bagote
 for Madagascare at publick sail & packed
 her cargo

 from Port St. Louis & arrived
 at 5 P.M. at Port St. Louis
 on Madagascare where the ship
 is lost the belongs to Cape Spring

 taking cargo at 2 P.M. finished employed
 taking care of the sick middle of
 latter part the same do ends
