

Ship Board of New Bedford in the
Remarks On Board Saturday March 31st 1839

First Part of the 24 hours Commences with Gentle Breeze from the S.W. with Squalls of rain, 14 of the Crew of Duty at 11 AM the Police came on board & took them on shore to the Council, went through an Examination, Manuel Drouin, not found guilty came on board to his duty, the rest of them 13 in number Pled guilty, by the Order of the Council they were lodged in Prison for further Examination, latter Part Gentle Breeze & Squalls to End the 24 hours

Remarks On Board Sunday March 31st 1839

First Part of the 24 hours Commences with Gentle Breeze & Pleasant Weather Ship lying at anchor off the Bell by with 13 of the Crew in Prison, Middle Part fresh Breeze & Squalls latter Part light Winds & variable with Pleasant weather Ship lying at anchor off the Bell by, with thirteen of the Crew as above in Prison

Remarks On Board Monday April 1st 1839

First Part of the 24 hours Commences with Gentle Breeze from the S.W. & Pleasant Weather with 3 latter Parts Gentle Breeze from the S.W. with Pleasant Weather Ship lying off the Bell by at anchor with thirteen of the Crew in Prison to End the 24 hours

Indian Ocean lying at anchor at the Isle of France

Remarks On Board Tuesday April 2nd 1839

First Part of the 24 hours Commences with light winds from the S.W. with squalls of rain latter Part Gentle Breeze from the S.W. & Pleasant Weather Ship lying at anchor off the Bell by with 13 of the Crew in Prison to End the 24 hours

Remarks On Board Wednesday April 3rd 1839

First Part of the 24 hours Commences with Gentle Breeze from the S.W. with Pleasant Weather Middle Part fine Weather, latter Part Gentle Breeze & rain at noon sent a shoe the Chest & Part of the clothing belonging to the Crew that is in Prison, by the Request of the American Council, he taking "Prison" under his Command to send to the 26 Lot, for meeting on Board of the Ship to End the 24 hours

Remarks On Board Thursday April 4th 1839

First Part of the 24 hours Commences with light Winds & rain Middle & latter Parts Gentle Breeze with Pleasant Weather Ship lying at anchor off the Bell by to End the 24 hours Employed in sending up our Logmaster Spending Chit some 30,
