steering the Ship NW under all Sail So Ends these 24 hours
employed in Ship's Duty, Ship making one hundred strokes an hour,

boats with out success at 4 P.M. steered the Ship off West
on her own & set standing Sails under all Sail So Ends these
24 hours employed in Ship's Duty.
