Friday Dec 4

Comes in with strong gales from the S S W At 6 P M mizzen sail middle part set the topgallentail Later part fresh gales to Bodes

Saturday Dec 5

Comes in with strong gales from the S S W with squalls middle and later much the same steering S S E to Bodes the day

Sunday Dec 6

Comes in with gales from the S S W middle and later much the same steering S S E as fast the wind will carry us this is D Bakers 4 ends another rugged day

Monday Dec 7

Commences with fresh gales from S S W At 1 P M set D bark ship steering to the S S W by the middle and later strong gales from S S W heading under Ebst reef topsails

Commences with strong gales at N W ship under double reef topsails steering East Middle and later part the same

Thursday Dec 10

Light winds from S W steering East with all sail with D heavy swell from the N W Middle and later part strong gales W S W ship under double reef topsails
