 Comes in with strong Gales and squalls
 from the Westward Steering by the wind
 to the Northward under short sail
 Middle part more moderate with
 A heavy swell Later part Calm
 this day we have had A Concel
 Game with the Moravia of Newport
 104 days out 25th Feb Lat by Obs 53:45
