Beaching sails. Dred sorting & preparing
Lat by Obs 15:00

Thursday 25

All this 24 hours light breezes from the
S.E. steering N.W. by compass with all
sent to the breeze the watch employed
gave in and the same as yesterday
this day was decorated with birds. Dred
was out overboard and the boat
shot out here & there. Lat by Obs 13:30.5
Long by Chron 99:42 W

Friday 26

Came in with light breezes from the
S.E. steering N.W. at 4 P.M.
saw blackfish. Dred the boat. Dred
captured one this night and have it
planned. Later fine. Lat by Obs 12:50

Saturday 27

All this 24 hours fine breezes from the
S.E. steering N.W. saw 10 Linnæus
fish that is about all

Sunday April 2 1847

Throught this 24 hours fresh breezes from the
S.E. and pleasant steering N.W. by N.W. with
all sail sent to the breeze saw one finback
passed to D. Fishback & back another fine
subvent. Whaler travelling about your wife
shot my daughter. Lat by Obs 3:50.11
Long by Chron 111:21 W

Monday 3

Throught this 24 hours light breezes
from the S.E. ship heading N.W. by N.W.
saw one ship one finback & back the
cooper steering star. Lat by Obs 5:00
Long by Chron 116:54 W

Tuesday 4

All this 24 hours light breezes from the
S.E. steering N.W. by N.W. saw 10 finback
of flying fish. Lat by Obs 6:18 W

Wednesday 5

Came in with light breeze from the S.E.
at 10 P.M. had quite a thunder storm
with rain. Later sent wind hauled
to the Eastward with squalls and rain
the watch employed reaching again
Lat by Obs 7:10 W
Long by Chron 119:28 W
