

Wednesday May 26 1846
 Throughout this 24 hours Light breeze from the
 Eastward steering to the westward looking for
 whales but to no purpose saw one finback
 Later part Light too Dead shorted sail for
 the Night breeze
 Lat by Hs 56:40
 Long by Chr 158:25

Thursday 27
 All the 24 hours strong wind and Light
 breeze plenty of fog and no whales could
 be seen

Friday 28
 Throughout this 24 hours Light breeze from
 the Northward and Eastward Dead no whales
 seen

Saturday 29
 Have seen six crabs from house at
 11 AM to make it look like the day we
 have had fine weather saw whales and heard
 the boats they turned out to be humpbacked
 that is my luck if any others were seen we
 have I felt about this time she would pay
 for me this night home sweet home
 Lat by Hs 55:50
 Long by Chr 158:25

Sunday 30
 This last 24 hours Light breeze from all parts
 of the compass Clear and foggy saw plenty
 of humpbacked Dead finbacks one dead
 with whale Dead some saw fellow had
 taken his jacket off Captained one before
 fresh breeze at noon Good in Good

Monday 31 1846
 Comes in with Light breeze from the S.W. steering
 by the wind to the Northward Dead shorted sailing
 to find the land in a thick fog much middle
 part More than saw great quantity of humpbacks
 At 12 M wind the land bearing off 1/2 off by compass
 Cannot see one right whale which saw many
 A better day than we are in months from home
 haven't made muchship fine prospects for it
 young men to think about being it fairer
 Later part tucked sails steering to the Eastward
 At first as the wind will carry in Cold so Good
 Lat by Hs 56:40
 Long by Chr 158:25

Tuesday 1
 Comes in with fresh breeze from the S.W.
 Dead breeze Middle part Much the same
 saw plenty of humpbacks Later part the
 strong breeze from the N.E. heading to
 the Southward under it that was rainstorm
 Dead forest in it thick rainstorm Cold
 Lat by Hs 57:05

Wednesday 2
 First part of these 24 hours strong gale from
 the Eastward steering to the Southward under
 short sail Middle part foggy Later wind
 headed to the south more than Dead under
 plenty of humpbacks that is all we can see
 In Good Another gloomy day under short sail
 the vessels all night in Good in Good
