At 8 P. M. saw the second time. And
Came on board the same as yesterday
Three ships in sight saw two of them
take one whale. These four fellows
I am glad for them however unless know
where we shall get one. All hands look
down in the water. I think I shall be able
to say I wish had four after this. It this
Don't put it follow in mind where he
has been before. There may come that. For
Horse. What horse for seals with the fog
I think that you can hang my hat on it.

Thursday June 18 1847

Came in with light breeze from the Eastward. And
I think fog. Middle part fine weather. At 6 P. M.
saw whale. Saw the boats but to say few more
ships in sight two saying that is our ship
of that. So bad with. I think fog. And bad

Came in with calm And heavy. Middle
part fine. At 12 M. saw whales. Saw but
to say few more. Three ships in sight two
saying so bad with. I think fog. And bad
