

Sunday July 16 1847

the last three or four days light winds and
calms blowing and steering down this last
day being light breeze and heavy sea
the Cooper has got two ~~small~~ barrels so much
and one ship

Lat by obs 54° 18' N
Long by obs 142° 13' W

Saturday July 17

Throughout this 24 hours light breeze from the
Eastward with a thick fog and rain saw
two humpbacks one ship so much No obs

Sunday July 18

Came in with a thick fog Middle part
later part fine weather saw whales
saw the Bear boat struck the coast
boat killed took him blowing side
last being in suspense the whale
to make 150 lbs saw two ships
so much saw my watch below

Monday July 19

Came in with fine weather till 10 A.M.
saw whales saw struck and down
Middle part later part thick and
breeze gusting with Captain
Munn saw Captain Devereux first
so much the Bevalitch D Boyling

Tuesday July 20

Came in with a thick fog Middle part
now clear saw whales saw but to see
four points later part thick rain storm
in Cape Boyling saw Captain Devereux
thinks he has got D whale

Wednesday July 21 1847

All the first of this 24 hours thick fog present
Boysling later part more clear and calm
saw nothing in the whole time so much

Thursday July 22

Throughout this 24 hours light winds and less
weather plenty of fog and sea rain saw one
humpback All barrels employed steering down
Lat by obs 59° 20' N
Long by obs 143° 29' W

Friday July 23

Came in with a thick fog Middle part more
clear saw great many of humpbacks steering
All ways looking for right whale later part
Thursday July 24 M we had a narrow so much
Lat by obs 58° 49' N
Long by obs 144° 45' W

Saturday July 24

Throughout this 24 hours fresh breeze from the
S.W. steering to the Eastward the watch employed
saw saw great plenty of humpbacks
so much weather long day Lat by obs 58° 51' N

Sunday July 25

Came in with strong breeze and heavy
Middle part later part more moderate
saw two states dead whales they had lost their
suckers so much trying to get to the southward
Eastward foggy Lat by obs 58° 8' N
