Tuesday Th 27
 Throught this 24 hours Light breezes from
 the S.W. with A thick fog saw one
 Whight whale heard but to no purpose
 the watch Employed mending the boat
 steering to the S.E. At lbs

Wednesday Th 28
 Throught this 24 hours Light Air from the
 Easterd steering to the S.E. with A thick
 fog the watch Employed mending the boat
 Lat by lbs 55.14

Thursday Th 29
 Came in with Calms And thick fog
 Middle And later part pleasant And
 Calms saw one Grampus two birds
 Mending the boat Lat by lbs 54.64
 Long by Chron 139.54

Friday Th 30
 Came in with fine weather saw whales
 heard but to no purpose. Middle part fog
 later part more clear saw great many
 of whales heard twice but to no purpose
 saw two ships so early under short
 sail for the night

Saturday July Th 31 1847
 Saw whales heard the west boat struck
 And killed took him Along side
 Lat by lbs 54.20

August Th 1
 Saw whales heard the west boat struck
 And killed took him Along side but him
 in Commencet byling saw six ships
 fine weather Lat by lbs 54.20

August Th 2
 Came in with Calms saw whales heard but
 to no purpose so early byling saw two ships

August Th 3
 Came in with A thick fog. Middle more
 clear saw whales heard in Commencet
 with the ship I B General Captain Massey
 but to no purpose so early with A thick
 fog byling

August the fourth We took A whale And cut
 him in Commencet byling the Grampus watch
 below good

August the 5 Light breezes with A thick fog
 saw one ship the Bowditch is A byling

August the 6 strong breezes And heavy
 fog the ship went on of finbacks
 five whales this season the Bowditch
 A byling
 August Th 7 Much the same as the last
