Pleasant steering south Lat by Obs 36:53
Saw finbackse

September 29th Thruwight this 24 hours fine
breezes from the westward steering E S E
the Cooper employed making breakers so ends
hazy saw one finbackse

October 30th All this 24 hours fine breezes
from the Westward steering E S E hazy
Saw Land and an whales No Obs
I had a most Delightful dream last night
I saw Heaven's heaven only known
when it will come to pass I thought
I see myself on those happy banks
Home sweet home

September October 1st Thruwight this
24 hours strong breezes from the
N W steering E S E hazy Land
for sperm whales he turned out
to be a sulpher bottom the Cooper
At work the same so ends
saw double reef topsails for the
height Lat by Obs 31:45
Long by Chron 115:50

September 2nd October 2nd All this 24 hours
fresh breezes from N W steering E S E
Saw finbackse so ends Another
Whale and an whales Lat by Obs 31:10
Long by Chron 115:25

October 3rd Thruwight this 24 hours fine
breezes from the N W steering to the southward
And Eastern with all sail sent to the fore
& the Land in sight so ends Another submille
some B thinking your wife and my Daughter
At sundown let go the anchor Lat by Obs 30:45
in turtle bay

October 4th All hands on shore looking for
Whales gunning sealing mauling bluncking
shedding and shagging so ends Laying
At anchor in turtle bay

October 5th Laying At anchor in turtle Bay
All hands on shore A sunrise At 4 P M
took our anchor and put to sea so ends

Thruwight this 24 hours Light Bree
And Calms the watch employed
shelling much the Land in sight
Distance 20 miles the Cooper At work
the same Lat by Obs 29:45

October 6th Thruwight this 24 hours Calms
saw six sunfish the Land in sight
Lat by Obs 29:10

October 7th & 8th Calms in with Light
breezes from the westward Laying off and
on Cooper's Island At sunrise kept off
At 4 P M sent four boats on shore
At whaling saw one sulpher bottom
And that was our shear of line
the boats on board steering to southward
