has got about through his breakers

Lat by the 26:31

Monday October the 10 Throught this 24 hours
Strong breezes from the N.W. steering to the
Northward and Eastward. Looking for
Whales saw two sulphurbottoms and one turtle
And that is our share of these this day
Look much like trying to form our holding
To how I hope heaven will send us nothing
before another sunset Lat by the 26:27
The land in sight

October the 11 Comes in with strong breezes
Middle land later part moderate steering
to the southward saw a few turtle and
sunfish puppers wherever had two shags
came on board to give us a visit so Cook
the Cooper mending his Oulid jacket
Lat by the 26:01

October the 12 All this 24 hours Light
Breezes and looks the main land in sight
saw one Diamond fish the Cooper
making wampages ship heading
to the southward Lat by the 25:40

October the 13 All this 24 hours fine weather
Light breezes from the Northward sailing down
Coast the land saw humpbackes Margate bay
in sight to morrow will run daylong in
to fillips in about six weeks leave and
at 10 o'clock daylong off, Nord on Lat by the 24:54

October the 14 All this 24 hours fine weather
At daylight kept off for the bay saw humpback
It sundown let go the anchor in Margate
Bay sent the watch so Cook Lat by the 24:35

October the 15 All this 24 hours fine weather
Sailing At Anchor two boats searching the bay
and fishing the rest Bunting house

October the 16 Sailing At Anchor in fish bay
the brought two turtle now and then to
eat fish saw two humpbackes finest
Bunting the house so Cook pleasant
