Wednesday July 12th
Comes in foggy 11 AM 4 boats saw Whales
Dried Between the fog signals struck
And killed but time in And Dried again
But to see purpus Later part five saw
five ships three of them Boiling the
Boarded is 10 Boiling Again the Cooper
is round the fishes 10 lbs
the Land in sight

Comes in foggy Speak three Curvians
