

Thursday August 25
Strong breeze imbedged fogging Mt 20
finished later about imbedged steering down
saw finbacks saw one sail Lat 47° 15' 00"
Long 148° 50'

Friday August 26
Light breezes and fog imbedged steering down
Cib between decks saw nothing Lat 46° 2'
Long 148° 40'

Saturday August 27
Light breezes with fog at times imbedged
steering down saw finbacks saw the land
bearing south distance 15 miles at 6 finished
steering down 200 lbs Lat 45° 50'

Sunday August 28
Light breezes and squalls of fog saw 8
sail later part finbacks Lat 46° 15'
Long 147° 50'

Monday August 29
Strong breezes steering to the southward
saw an upright whale humpbacks and
finbacks later part spunk the ship
Aboard of Harpoon Lat 47° 00'
Long 146° 20'

Tuesday 30
Strong breezes spunk the ship part spunk
1000 lbs this season saw whales heard
but to no purpose later part thick foggy
saw whales round the ship
Lat 47° 00'
Long 146° 20'

Wednesday August 31 1848
Calms thick fog heard whales spunking
round the ship saw the moon with the light
day later part clear saw whales chased
brought nothing saw several sail Lat 47° 15'
Long 147° 50'

Thursday August 26
Light breezes saw whale heard but to no
purpose saw 12 sail later heard and
brought nothing Lat 47° 14'
Long 147° 40'

Friday August 27
Light breezes saw 10 ships saw 10 plenty
of whales all the ships 10 whaling were
struck one and part of the line later
part heard but to no purpose Lat 47° 20'
Long 147° 50'

Saturday August 28
the boats still off 10 whaling at 3 struck
and killed and took the whale to the
ship but him in Lat 47° 30'
Long 148° 00'

Sunday August 29
Gentle breezes saw whales struck the whale
run to the windward Lat 47° 15' gave
saw 10 number of ships later imbedged
fogging and chasing whales
Lat 47° 15'
Long 146° 10'
