and rainy saw ships entering

Strong breezes and rough weather with squalls
saw several ships spoke the ship mechanic
of Newport the bark dock of Sag Harbor

Sunday September 5

Strong gales and rough in places strong
breeze waiting 50 lbs to fill up good
later found clear and pleasant

Long 150° 45'

Monday September 6

Light breezes with fog saw several sails
later found strong breeze spoke the ship
Albatross

Tuesday 7

Calms at 2 P.M. whales heard but
could not get him in command
Beyling

Wednesday Sept 8

Light breezes with fog spoke the
ships Albatross Pelican and full bound
to the Sandwich Islands in company
Beyling waiting for a fair wind
