Sunday Oct 16

Strong breezes from N & E steering S by W
At 6 PM saw the East end of moon
bearing S W At 12 passed it by the foremast
the North light and hauled up
into the harbour and came to in 12
fathoms of water with the last lower
SD great number of ships two
observed to mention

October 18

Can with the water employed
Drying on our water as show our working
Ship and painting ship watering getting
ready for home some short time

Monday November 1

At 6 PM the latitude same one bound
Main all sail and steam out S & E
and S & E by S with D strong breeze from
E & N Middle part wind light later part
Main breezes saw one ship to East East

on N wind on different tacks clear
pleasant weather
