Monday Nov 20
Came in with Calms Middle North later
faint fresh breezes with squalls of rain
steering by the wind to the south
the watch employed at various jobs
Lat by Obs 41° 25'
Long by Chron 155° 20'

Tuesday Nov 21
Light Ners from E N E steering by the wind
to the S E later faint squalls with fresh
breezes Lat by Obs 91° 46'
Long by Chron 154° 52'

Wednesday November 22
Light breezes from E N E steering by the
wind to the S E Light squalls of rain
Middle North later faint Light Ners the
watch employed mending sails Lat by Obs 11° 26'

Thursday Nov 23
Light breezes and pleasant steering by the
wind the watch employed mending sails
Lat by Obs 12° 58'

Friday November 24
Light winds and pleasant weather
steering to South the watch employed
making spinnaker and sheet
Lat by Obs 16° 14'
Long by Chron 153° 34'

Saturday Nov 25
Light Ners and Calms saw two birds
and sent two stunsels Lat by Obs 15° 26'
Long by Chron 153° 20'
