Comes in with fresh breeze from the S. W.
Steering by the wind to the S. & Middle Wind
Later from strong breeze from N. S. W.

Steering S. & E. under single reef topsails
Split the jib so Ends with N. fair wind
Glorious Lat by Obs 31:14

Wednesday Dec 18th
Steering Gale from S. W. Steering S. & E.
under single reef topsails Later from
More moderate wind tending to the Southward
Saw one Gannet Lat by Obs 31:46
Long by Chron 149:20

Thursday Dec 19th
All this 24 hours Light Calms with
N. heavy swell tending N. over topsails
the Cooper at work Lat by Obs 31:45

Friday Dec 20th
Light N. Wind from N. E. Steering S. & E. Middle
Wind Later from fine breeze from North

Saturday Dec 21th
All this 24 hours fine breeze from the North
Steering S. & E. with N. sail sent to the
