 bearing E.S. saw one ship saw whales
 Doubtful to Grids under short sail
 Left two for the night the Land Distance
 18 miles Lat by the 34.14
 Long by the 12.2

November 13
 Comes in with fine weather the Land in sight
 Although on shore fishing saw several
 humpbacks Middle part strong breeze the
 Boats are bound with plenty of fish at 2 P.M.
 Left off S by E saw two sails later part
 fine Lat by the 34.2 Long by the 12.2
 the Land bearing N.W. Distance 25 miles
