With A thick rain storm the Cooper
employed having N Grindstone Glory
N My Chummer Ligne Sweet Stone

December 17
Comes in with strong Breezes from
N E With A thick rain storm steering
by the Wind to the Eastward Middle
part Wind hauld to the N W
More Clear Later part pleasant
saw finbacke & Ends Another
Long Day Lat by Obs 44:50
Long by Chron 64:20

December 18 1852
Throught this 24 strong Breezes from
the Northward steering by the Wind to the
Eastward With A thick fog And raise
under short sail saw finbacke & Ends
Another Gloomy Day O My Chummer

Sunday December 19
Comes in with strong Gale from the Northward
Steering to the Eastward under A Close reef
Main topsail ranging Middle part wind hauld
to the Eastward More Moderate Later part
Clear With All sail set saw one sail
saw nothing in the whole Line so Ends
Lat by Obs 39:54
Long by Chron 66:00

December 20
All this 24 hours fine Breezes from the
Eastward And Pleasant S S E under All sail
the Hatch employed Bunnell Bone
Clear Wee saw four moths from some
only 70 lbs it looks kinder dark
But i hope the Good Lord will look
upon us O My Chummer if could
But this Night God only knows

December 21
All this 24 fine Breezes from the Eastward
And pleasant steering S S E the Cooper
employed repairing old water trunks
saw nothing in the whole Line
