All this 24 hours from North Pleasant
Light Brees from the S. M. Steaming N. N. &
With the sail set to the Brees at 12 M
saw Hunter's island. Baring N. N. W.
Distance 30 miles the Cooper employed
at various jobs so ends Lat by Obs 22:26
Long by Obs 171:56

Sunday March 6

All this 24 hours Light Brees from S. M.
to S. C. with Light signals of rain Steaming
to the Northward. Found Eastern saw ~~the~~ ship
saw five Ducks. Light Ground fine prospects
so ends Weather. Submerse Therm. select 36

March 7

Light Brees from S. C. Steaming N. N. W.
so ends with pleasant Lat by Obs 24:40
Long by Obs 175:30

March 8

All this 24 hours Light Brees from
Cubor Steaming N. N. W. & Brought one
Shark so ends Lat by Obs 19:21
Long by Obs 176:30

March 9

Therewith this 24 hours Light Brees
from the south Steaming N. N. W. M.
saw the former Islands Baring N. N. W.
Distance 30 miles so ends with
Pleasant Lat by Obs 14:20

March 10

All this day Light Brees from the
South Steaming N. N. W. Brought one
Shark saw Land Distance 35 miles
the Hatch employed mending sails
so ends with pleasant Lat by Obs 16:10

March 11

Light Brees from South Steaming
N. N. W. & saw nothing so ends very
warm North pleasant

March 12

Light Brees from the Southern North
Steaming N. N. W. saw the Island off
Rotterdam Baring N. N. W. Distance 45 on
so ends with Calm Lat by Obs 13:02

March 13

Light Brees from Calm to Land
in sight Distance 20 miles N. N. W.
the Boat went on shore to trade
saw the beach with two loads off
front the Natives so ends very warm

March 14

Light Brees from Calm to Land
in sight saw one sail
