

Remarks While Lying at Hong Kong.

Wednesday Jan^y the 29th

all this day light variable air and fine weather all hands employed stowing the off the fore hatch way and cleaning ship

Thursday Jan^y the 30th

all this day strong trades and fair weather all hands employed with sundry jobs at 9 AM took on board 9 1/2 tons of water

Friday Jan^y the 31st

all this day strong trades and cold cloudy weather. Employed painting &c

Saturday February the 1st

all this day light breeze and cloudy weather, the Starboard Watch on Liberty at 9 AM Edward Saunders, refused to go to duty and I put him in Iron and at 12 M, he made acknowledgement and I took off the Iron and he went to duty

Sunday February the 2nd

all this day fresh breeze, cold and cloudy weather, the Starboard Watch on Liberty Antone, Renes boat Steerer, & William Jackson both Portuguese, was put in Prison last night for Stealing Whale Bone from the Ship Aeronaut of Mysie

Monday February the 3rd

all this day fresh breezes with cold cloudy weather the Starboard Watch on Liberty Antone, and William Jackson is sentenced to 6 months hard labour on the high ways, of her Majesty Colony Hong Kong,

Tuesday February the 4th

all this day calm and cloudy the Starboard Watch on Liberty the Watch employed with sundry jobs the Cooper setting up Shooks for Water

Wednesday February the 5th

all this day fresh breezes from the North and fair weather the Starboard Watch on Liberty Employed putting in a New Pump the Starboard side

Remarks While at Anchor at Victoria, Hongkong,

Thursday February the 6th

all this day light breezes and fine weather, the Starboard Watch on Liberty the Starboard Watch Employed with sundry jobs about the ship this day Charles Rodgers Deserted

Friday February the 7th

all this day strong trades from the East with cold cloudy weather the Starboard Watch on Liberty the Cook Silas Freeman was brought on board by the Police, having exceeded his liberty 10 hours received from shore 100 pickles of Irish potatoes and 4 Dozen Pumpkins, & 200 lbs of Onions

Saturday February the 8th

all this day light breezes and fair weather, the Starboard Watch on Liberty some time in the night Edward Saunders Deserted the Watch Employed with sundry jobs about the ship and took on board 20 pickles of Sweet potatoes the Capt on shore with a badly sprained ankle it being some better to day, at 9 AM James Ashby came on board the duty having shipped before the Counsel

Sunday Feb^y the 9th

this day strong trades and cold cloudy weather the Starboard Watch on Liberty the Capt Ankle some better to day

Monday Feb^y the 10th

all this day strong trades and fair weather the Starboard Watch on Liberty took on board 11 tons of water and wet the oil in the hole, the Capt Ankle a fraction better to day

Tuesday Feb^y the 11th

all this day light air and fine weather the Starboard Watch on Liberty James Buckley and Robert Heller, have not returned on board and their chests being empty it is presumed they have Deserted Employed through the day sanding sails and getting ready for sea the Captains some better to day
