

Remarks While on the Passage towards the Sandwich Islands

Saturday October the 4th 1851

Commences with a strong gale from the S by E and cloudy rugged weather, the ship heading S by E under Double reefed top sails and courses, at 4 P.M. raised the Dead, at 7 P.M. more moderate and let one reef out of the top sail, the wind veering gradually to the East, at 12 M. let the rig out of the main top sail & set the main top gallant sail at 4 A.M. set all sail heading S by E, the latter part a strong breeze and cloudy, the Watch Employed refitting the rigging
Lat By Obs 38.40 North, Long By Chron 179.30 East

Sunday October the 5th

Commences with a strong breeze from the Eastward, the ship with all sail set by the wind heading S by E, the Middle and latter Moderate breezes and heavy
Lat By Obs 37.20 North, Long By Chron 178.45 East

Monday October the 6th

the first part of these twenty four hours a light breeze from the Eastward and heavy weather the ship by the wind with all drawing sail set heading S by E, the Middle part calm, at 3 P.M. a light breeze from the S by E and wore ship to the East, at daylight set the Royals, the latter part a light breeze and pleasant weather, the Watch Employed mending stitching the sails,
Lat By Obs 36.53 North, Long By Chron 178.55 East

Tuesday October the 7th

Commences with a light breeze from the S by E and fine weather the ship with all sail set steering East, at midnight the breeze hauling to the S by W and set the Starboard Studding sails, from 4 to 8 A.M. light squalls with rain the latter part a brisk breeze from the S by W with passing clouds
Lat By Obs 36.11 North, Long By Chron 178.40 West

Thursday October the 9th

Commences with a brisk breeze from the S by W, with fair weather the ship with all drawing sail set steering East, at 1 P.M. took a squall with rain same time hauled in the Studding sails & furled the Royals, at 10 P.M. the wind changed in a squall from the North, the part equally with some rain the latter part a strong breeze and fair weather, the Watch Employed repairing sails and with sundry jobs on the rigging.

Remarks

Thursday October the 9th

Continues a strong breeze from the North with fair weather at 1 P.M. set the main Royal & flying jib, course East, the Middle part light breezes from the S by W, the latter part calm and pleasant, at daylight unbent the main sail & jib to repair
Lat By Obs 35.07 North, Long By Chron 172.40 West

Friday October the 10th

Continues calm and pleasant, at 2 P.M. took a light air from the Westward, kept the ship East and set all the Studding sails, at 4 P.M. bent the main sail & jib & unbent the main top sail & bent another, at 9 P.M. the breeze hauled to the South with fine weather, the latter part a pleasant breeze from the S by W, the Watch Employed with various jobs about the ship & rigging
Lat By Obs 34.46 North, Long By Chron 171.30 West

Saturday October the 11th

Commences with a brisk breeze from the S by W and pleasant weather, the ship with all sail set steering East, the Watch Employed mending the rigging and Middle stitching the sails, at 8 P.M. the wind shifted in a squall from the North, hauled in the Studding sails and shifted them to the Port and furled the fore Royal, the Middle part brisk breeze and pleasant, at 4 A.M. the wind veered to the S by E in Studding sails and braced sharp heading S by E, the latter part brisk breezes veering to the Eastward, the Watch variously Employed
Lat By Obs 33.36 North, Long By Chron 169.40 West

Sunday October the 12th

Commences with a brisk breeze from the East and fair weather, ship by the wind heading S by E, the Middle part light breezes and the latter part calm and pleasant, Lat By Obs 32.26 North, Long By Chron 169.40 West

Monday October the 13th

Continues calm and pleasant, through the night a light air from the S by W, course East, with all sail set, at 8 A.M. calm again and at 9 put out the Bow & Waist Boats the Watch Employed Drying the Boats & with sundry jobs on the rigging was calm and warm pleasant weather.
