Remarks On Board Tuesday July 10<sup>th</sup> 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with fresh Breezes from the W & W. Ship of the North Part of the Islands of Brazil working up with the land at 5 PM finished Beasting at our Baler at 6 PM with the Fore & Mizzen Topsails blowing heavy & thick hazy weather Middle & Latter Parts Fresh Breezes from the S W Ship of the West Side of Brazil So Ends these 24 hours all hands Employed in Ships duty

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 11<sup>th</sup>

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Breezes from the W & W at 2 PM got off the harbour of Good Land a Boat went on shore to get recruits 30 at 6 PM Boat came on Board Middle Part Light Winds from W & West Ship lying at anchor Latter Part Light Winds with fog & Rain So Ends these 24 hours all hands Employed.

Remarks On Board Thursday July 12<sup>th</sup>

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Light Winds & some foggy at 3 PM the recruits came off a long line of the Ship took them on Board at 6 PM left the Ship off G. by South Middle Part thick hazy weather Latter Pleasant weather with gentle Breezes from the Westward Steering the Ship S by E So Ends these 24 hours all hands Employed in Ships duty

Remarks On Board Friday July 13<sup>th</sup> 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with gentle Breezes from the NE & Pleasant weather Steering the Ship S by E At 5 PM saw a Sail off the weather Bow Steering to the N East Middle Part Light Winds and foggy weather Steering the Ship South Latter Part Light winds & Pleasant weather So Ends these 24 hours all hands Employed in Ships duty

Remarks On Board Saturday July 14<sup>th</sup> 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with light Winds from the West Steering the Ship South Middle Part Light Winds with showers of Rain and some fog at 6 PM Commence Steering South by East Latter Part Light Winds from the S W West and Pleasant weather Steering the Ship South at 12 PM finished Steering Down all So Ends these 24 hours all hands Employed in Ships duty

Remarks On Board Sunday July 15<sup>th</sup> 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with light Winds from the West West Steering the Ship South Middle Part Light Winds intermixed with Calms Latter Part Light Winds from the S W West and Pleasant weather Steering the Ship South So Ends these 24 hours all hands Employed in Ships duty

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
