Remarks On Board Tuesday July 31st 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Gentle
Breeze from the NW West Ship heading on a wind
to the South Middle Part Fresh Breeze. Latter Part Strong
Breeze from the S West Ship heading S E East on a wind
under all Sail to Ends these 24 hours all hands
Employed in Ships Duty.

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 1st 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh
Breeze from the S W. Ship heading on a wind
to the S E. at 11 Am Tacked Ship to the NW W. Middle
Part Gentle Breeze from the S W & Pleasant weather
at 10 Am Tack two Sail off the Starboard beam. Standing
to S E. one of them was a Barke Ship & hoisted French
Colours. Did not see the other being some Distance off. Latter Part
Gentle Breeze from the S W half S. Ship heading on a
wind to the NW West to Ends these 24 hours all hands
Employed in Ships Duty.

Remarks On Board Thursday August 2nd 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Light winds
from the S E W ship heading on a wind NW by N
at 2 Pm Tacked Ship to the S E Middle Part Light winds
from S E W and Pleasant weather Ship heading on a wind
to the S E. One Barke Ship in Sight to the leeward
Standing to the S E to Ends these 24 hours all hands
Employed in Ships Duty.
