First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Light Winds from NW by N Ship heading on a wind to the SE by W under all sail at 11 AM took in sail and by the ship had to the SE by W under Double reef Top Sails Middle Part Winds from the SE by W Ship heading NW by W at 6 AM made all sail on the ship Latter Part Gentle Breeze and pleasant weather to End these 24 hours all hands Employed in repairing the Feb 30^d

Remarks On Board Monday October the 3^d 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Gentle Breeze from the North and Pleasant weather Steaming the ship NW by W at 6 AM took in the Light Sails Doubled reef the Top Sails Middle Part Fresh Breeze from the North at 8 AM wind freshened on to a heavy Gale took in the sail and let the ship come to on a Wind under a Close reefed Main Top Sail heading to the NW by W Latter Part Blew a heavy Gale with thick rainy weather

Remarks On Board Sunday October the 4th 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Gale from the NW by W with a heavy sea running Ship heading to the West under a Close reefed Main Top Sails at 3 PM made all sail at 6 AM made all sail on the ship Latter Part Fresh Breeze from the SE by W Steaming the ship SE by W to End these 24 hours all hands Employed in Ship's Duty

Remarks On Board Thursday October 5th 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Breeze and thick rainy weather Wind from the South Steaming the ship West at 5 PM Wind freshened to a Gale took in the sail and let the ship come to on a Wind under a Close reefed Main Top Sails and Spencer's Riddle Part more moderate at 6 AM let Double reefed Top Sails Latter Part Gentle Breeze from the South with fine weather at 9 AM saw a Whaler barhore and several fin backs Steaming the ship West to End these 24 hours all hands Employed

Remarks On Board Saturday October 6th 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Gentle Breeze from the NW by W Ship heading to the NW by W under all sail fine Pleasant Weather saw several Finbacks at 6 PM took in sail Middle Part Fresh Breeze from the NW by W Ship heading to the NW by W under Short sail at 6 AM let Double reefed Top Sails Ship heading NW by W Latter Part Gentle Gale from the NW by W with thick heavy weather with showers of rain at 11 AM took in the Fore & Main Top Sails Ship heading West under Short sail to End these 24 hours all hands Employed

Remarks On Board Sunday October 7th 1838

First Part of these 24 hours Commences with Fresh Gale with thick rainy weather wind from the North Ship heading West under Short sail Middle Part the same at 7 AM turned the Boat up & down the ship to the N East Latter Part Fresh Gale from the NW by W with heavy showers of rain Ship heading on a wind to the N by N under Short sail to End these 24 hours all hands Employed
