Thursday the 29th

Passage to Colbo Sea

A fine breeze from S. at 6. Am. masted sail
attended lookouts aloft. Broke out fore main &
after hatches pretty good for one day.
At 10.30 a.m.

Commenced fine with a light breeze at 7.30 a.m.
All hands on deck for ship duty as usual at 10 a.m.
Decalmed. At 5.30 chose Boat crew and commenced
drill for Practice.

Saturday 31st

Calm & clear at daylight stationed lookouts
Aloft, called all hands at 7.30 for ship duty.
At 8.30 a light breeze springing up from S.E.
at 10 a.m. raised a sail 2 points on weather
Bona bark bound to the S.W.

Sunday morning Nov the 1st

Light wind and Hazy

With a heavy swell

Monday 2nd

Commenced with a strong wind from S.E.
At 8.30 A.M. took in fore & main sail, at 4.30 took in
Main top Gallies sail and washed decks.
At 5 P.M. wind increasing set boat on upper Grand

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Thursday the 3rd

Wind increasing at 10 A.M. Cleared down
After reef fore and Main top sail, hauled down and
Towed the jib & furler main Mast. Took
Crew out the Boat and turned Boat
Pop. At 10 P.M. wind abated tossed jib
& took out reefs and set main & sail.
At 10.45 heavy rain

Wed the 4th

Clear with a nice breeze from S.E.W. at
4.30 S.M. set fore top Gallant sail
At 5.45 squall took in fore & main top
Gallant sail. At 6.30 set them again.

Thurs 5th

Commenced with heavy wind & rain at 10
Took in fore & main & sail, cleared down
& shouldered reefed. At 2 o'clock shook out
Reefs. At 4 P.M. reefed main & sail, and
hoisted up main sail at 7 P.M. set main
sail, at 8.30 wind more steady and
frequent showers of rain
