Sun the 15th

Mon the 16th

Commenced fine with a nice breeze from
S.E. at 6.30 stationer Lookouts aloft -
at 8.30 Port watch broke out after hole
at 10 A.M. broke out main hole for cash
At 1 o'clock P.M. broke out the run
And stowed it off again

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Tues the 17th Passage to Oosters Sea

Commenced with a strong breeze from S.E.
With rain. at 8.30 A.M. wind shifted.
At 4 o'clock strong wind and rain
At 6.30 P.M. took in Fore & main 75 sails
Cleared down & reefed the top sails

Wed the 18th

Commenced with strong wind from S.E.
With rain and sharp lightning. heavy rain
through out the day. at 6 o'clock P.M. minor
Hauled in the P.W. backed ship At 6.45
P.M. wind hauling eastward. backed again

Thurs the 19th

Light wind (with rain) at 4.30 A.M. wind S.E.
Backed ship. at 8 a.m. heavy showers of rain
At 4 o'clock a nice breeze from S.E. took

Fri the 20th

Clear with light wind from S.E. at 8.45 wind
Hauled to S.E. at 4.30 P.M. became calm at 1
Heavy showers of rain
