T. Monday, Dec. The 21st 1863.

Commenced with strong winds from N.W.
With thick weather bark steering S.E. by E.
At daylight commenced breaking out
Main hold and stowed down three casks
Of oil. At 6 O'clock P.M. washed of decks
At Sun down set again. M. Royal.

Tues the 22nd

Commenced with strong wind from N.W.
At daylight saw a Brig steering S.E. by E.
Continued stowing in fore hold
I put 45 Bbls Lard

Wed the 23rd

Commenced with strong wind from N.W.
With thick and heavy weather & steering
S.E. by E. at daylight commenced to stow
down in the hold. saw a French Bark
steering S.E. by E. At 2 P.M. finished
stowing down. saw a number of Fin Backs

Thursday, Dec. The 24th

1863

Commenced with light winds from N.W.
With thick weather at this steering S.E. by E.
At daylight saw a Bark steering S.E. by E.
O. off. saw a Schooner steering the same
At Sun down set M. Royal.

Fri the 25th

This day commenced with light winds from N.W.
At 8 A.M. hauled into the S. with thick weather
At 8.45 A.M. took in M. Royal.

Sat the 26th

Commenced with light winds from S.E. light
S.E.W. with heavy weather at 4 P.M.
Washed of decks & sides.

Sun the 27th

Moderate winds from S.E. thick & foggy.
At daylight saw a number of Fin Backs
At 5 A.M. saw a sail steering S. at 9
P.M. set Top Mast & furling sail
Wind from N.E. steering S.E.
