Commenced with light breeze wind at
Daylight the island of Bouro in sight
Hoisted all hands at daylight and made
Sail at 1 o'clock. Prof. (H. Webb) raised
A school of whales going quiet to windward
Lowered and got within 100 yds of them did not
bring to. ~~At 2 P.M. got through the line. turned up 23~~

Wednesday Feb. 17th 184

At daylight
Calm, commenced to cut in at 8 am
Finished cutting and stationed lookouts
Stop at 10 am (H. Webb) raised
Whales going to windward lowered but
Returned without success, started the

Thurs Feb. 18th

Light breeze wind, at daylight took
Out other hold for Beef, Pork & Beans
At 2 P.M. got through the line, turned up 23

Fri Feb. 19th

Commenced with light breeze wind, at
Daylight saw at sail running down
Picked the land

Sat Feb. 20th

Clear, light air from N.W. at 6 am
Was of the west end of Bouro, Squared
the sails & run off, at 2 P.M. (Cook) raised
Whales. Laid aboard Boat went on starboard
Two men against a whale but they did not
go in, returned with nothing.
