Whales

Sunday Feb the 21<sup>st</sup> 164

Commences

With light northerly wind 4.30 P.m.  
Raised a large breach but did not  
see any more of it

Mon 22<sup>nd</sup>

Clear with light wind from N.E.  
Standing off shore at daylight back  
Out water returned down to B.H. of  
Oils. Saw two whales. Boal running  
Off shore

Tues the 23<sup>rd</sup>

Calm and clear at daylight commen-  
ced to Kettle. Fore rigging at 10 a.m. had  
to work of work on account of heat  
The crew no one could stand it  
At Sundown Boreo about 2.5 miles off

Wed the 24<sup>th</sup>

Light easterly wind at daylight land  
10 miles off finished ridding men  
Employed in strips duty through  
the day at 5 P.m. raised whales 10 miles  
off. Did not succeed in striking

Thursday Feb the 25<sup>th</sup> 164

Light winds

From N.E. at 10 A.M. raised a sail off  
Our weather Bore at 2 P.M. saw an  
Other standing in shore at sun  
Down calm & clear

Fri the 26<sup>th</sup>

Commenced with a calm at 9 a.m.  
Pumped a cask of water in fore hold  
At 2 P.m. three sails at Sundown light  
Breeze from Westward

Sat the 27<sup>th</sup>

Light wind from Westward at day  
Light one sail in sight and land  
Finished off send down fore sail and  
Repaired and sent it up again  
At 5 P.M. saw a breach 10 miles off

Sun the 28<sup>th</sup>

Light easterly winds raised whales going  
to windward covered and chased until  
dark but did not strike
