Wednesday July 6th 1864

This day commenced with
a nice breeze from S.E. at daylight commenced
to cut in at 12 O'clock all cut in at 2 P.m.
Started the works.

Thurs 7th

Commenced with a nice breeze from S.E. at
day light sent 1 man aloft who reported
2 sails in sight - saw a large breach 10 miles
to windward, land about 10 miles off

Fri 8th

This day light wind from S.E. finished boiling at
daylight stationed one man at mast head
who reported 2 sails in sight - one whaler.
Coopers & stowage down & 100 in an hour.

Sat 9th

Comes in fine with a light breeze from S.E.
At daylight called all hands and made
preparations for stowing down found the
3rd Engraved tier badly rotten had to rest on a
few cast of water at 5:30 P.m. finished stowing

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Sunday July 10th 1864



Commenced fine with
strong breeze from S.E. at 9 A.m. raised a
school of whales of Linn. quarter at 11 A.m.
Landed three seals 2 small being landed up
with a sore hand. struck one ashore took him
to the ship. Whales did not bring to this day.

Mon 11th

This day strong breeze from S.E. employed
at cooping and boiling at 5 P.m. finished
Boiling. Saw seal down

Tues 12th

Strong breeze with thick foggy weather
At 8 P.m. ran a bit on the bow, men
employed at cooping oil.

Wed 13th

Strong winds from S.E. thick & foggy
Saw a number of Fin Backs, employed
at cooping & salting out & cc during
the day.

Thurs 14th

This day thick & foggy with strong S.E. wind
Employed at breaking out & salting down
during the day.
