Monday August 1st 1864

This day commences
With light wind from S.E. and haze, saw a
Number of Dutch her Bottoms, employed at
this duty during the day, a nice breeze
Continued from S.E.

Tues 2^d

Nice and pleasant light breeze from S.E.
At daylight Sea down about 10 miles off
Standing into the island of Batekian

Wed 3^d

Light south easterly wind and haze during
the day, employed at cooping and other
Duties of the Ship.

Thurs 4th

Commences with strong wind from S.E.
At daylight made preparations for stowing
Oil at 4 P.M. finished stowing.

Frid 5th

This day commences with heavy wind from
S.E. quite rugged during the day.

Saturday August 6th 1864

This day commences
With a nice breeze from S.E. and clear
Employed at cooping, a number of Dutch
in sight during the day, saw 3 sea down
Directly ahead

Sund 7th

This day commences clear with a good nice
Breeze from S.E. all was quiet during the day.

Mon 8th

Commences fine breeze from S.E. broke out
off for Key, Port and slope, painted on
Boat &c saw Sea down of the beam.

Tues 9th

Commences with a good breeze from S.E.
At 4 P.M. the island of Batekian about
10 miles off. Painted Starboard boat.

Wed 10th

Light wind from S.E. and haze at 8 a.m.
Land in sight 2 points on the bow.
