

At Tima island of Celebes

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Liberty

Wednesday September 24th 1864

Clear with a strong breeze from the sea S. at 2 o'clock went on shore for coals, at 7 a.m. returned with 8 cask, got breakfast sent on shore for 4 more to ship, at 2 P.M. went on shore to rod the remainder of the coals down the river to the beach

Thursday 29th

Strong wind from the sea at 4 A.M. sent boats after the remainder of coals

Friday 30th

Sent the raft in shore filled them Rodded them down, come on board and painted ship.

Saturday October 1st 1864

Commenced with a strong sea breeze, at 4 a.m. sent the boats in after the raft, returned at 6 a.m. got breakfast and sent the starboard watch on liberty, at sundown all returned to ship.

At Tima, Celebes

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Runaway

Sunday October 2nd 1864

Commenced with a strong sea breeze, at 7 a.m. sent Port Watch on liberty, & returned at sundown

Monday 3rd

This day strong breeze from the sea S. sent starboard watch on liberty, sent a boat after them at sundown but did not all come on board

Tuesday 4th

Pleasant with a light breeze of shore, Port Watch on liberty, at sundown sent the boat after the watch, all returned with the exception of two, Joseph Solomon a Portuguese, & Benjamin Wierine a Spangar who ran away

Wednesday 5th

Commenced with a light shore breeze, at 9 a.m. a strong breeze from S. sent the coast on shore for water returned at 8 o'clock a.m.
